

Regulatory Review of Drugs & Devices R2D2 Workshop



CAPRA will host a two-day workshop to provide an update from Health Canada on the substantial regulatory reform initiatives underway. The proposed topics include: health care system needs concept, health technology assessment collaboration with CADTH, Special Access Programme (SAP) renewal, Public Release of Clinical Information (PRCI) regulations/ guidance, use of foreign reviews/decisions, real world evidence life cycle integration and stop the clock mechanisms. Further, there will be the option to attend a concurrent session on medical device projects related to building better access to digital health technologies, real world evidence life cycle integration and the provision of early scientific advice for medical devices.

The event format will include presentations followed by breakout sessions to address specific questions posed by Health Canada and plenary sessions to present the feedback received.
