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## History of electronic submissions At Health Canada (TPD)

- eCTD received on laptop computer
  - Company viewer tool.
  - Limited searching capability
- PDF Files on CD
  - Limited searching capability
- Paper copy of the submission was always provided.

## What did we learn from these electronic submissions?

- Electronic submissions on laptop computer are of limited value.
  - Different viewer tool used for each submission received. Training is recurrent for each submission.
  - No link between the submission laptop computer and the desktop computer used for writing the report. Makes it difficult for copy and paste of information.
  - Time is spent to administer the handling of laptop computer.
- The used of scanned documents should be avoided where possible.

## What did we learn from these electronic submissions? Continued

- Ease of navigation is the key to friendly use (adoption) of electronic submissions
  - Adequate bookmarks
  - Never too many Hyperlinks
  - Search capability
- Quick access to information will result in time savings which will translate to a more efficient review process.
